

Instructions for Presentations

- (1) In each oral presentation room, a PC projector, and an overhead projector are available. A windows PC will be provided for presentation. Also your own computer can be used. The connection and the compatibility with your computer must be tested prior to the session. Two signal cables are available. The next speaker should connect his/her computer to the projector using a vacant cable and wait for his/her presentation time. If you need a slide projector and/or VCR, you are requested to contact the LOC office well in advance.
- (2) Posters are divided into two groups. Each group has a two-day presentation period. The posters of the first (second) group should be put in the morning on October 23 (25) and should be removed by the end of the session on October 24 (26). The size of each poster is 0.9 m (wide) by 2.1m (high). Please plan your exhibit to fit this space. The paper number will be indicated on the boards. Pins, tapes, and scissors for mounting posters will be supplied at the poster presentation room.
- (3) The all session rooms are strictly “No Smoking.” Smoking is permitted only in a designated area.
- (4) The oral presentation room A is “No Drinking” and “No Eating”. Refreshments will be available in the poster presentation room during each coffee-break and poster session.
